A larger number of lessons is taught in English, which makes up half of the curriculum.

The content follows thematic areas such as history and society, nature and science, skills and abilities, math and logic. This approach helps students develop a higher level of language proficiency and strengthens their ability to think and express themselves fluently in English.

About the Programme

Within the programme, students **attend specialised subjects taught in English**, including History and Society, Nature and Science, Skills and Abilities, Math and Logic. **Graduates are well prepared for studies at prestigious universities** in the Czech Republic and abroad. Half of all classes are delivered in English.

This enables students to master the language at an advanced level and to develop the ability to think, communicate and express ideas with confidence. In addition to English, students **can choose from several optional languages**: German, Spanish, French, Chinese or Japanese.

During excursions and field trips with lectures in English, students gain a unique chance to strengthen their language skills in real situations. We emphasise adaptability, communication, language responsiveness and cultural awareness.

Project days offer students an excellent opportunity to explore various topics such as ecology, effective learning methods, the world of work or practical applications of AI. All activities are led by a native English speaker.

Study stays abroad allow students to spend several months at partner secondary schools and fully immerse themselves in a different culture while improving their English in everyday life.
